WHAT?

Founded in 1880 as a school of oratory, Emerson is a private college that offers undergraduate and graduate degrees in the fields of communication and the performing arts. The College is organized into two schools. The School of the Arts offers programs in the Visual & Media Arts, the Performing Arts, and in Writing, Literature & Publishing. The School of Communication includes the departments of Journalism, Organizational & Political Communication, Marketing Communication and Communication Sciences & Disorders. An Institute for the Liberal Arts and Interdisciplinary Studies serves as a center for innovative teaching and scholarship in communication and the arts.

SPECIAL FEATURES

The collection of 200,000 items contains about 160,000 monographs, 11,000 nonprint items, 11,000 archival holdings, and 21,000 bound journals and microfilm holdings. In addition, the library subscribes to about 600 print journals and has online access to about 14,000 online periodicals as well as e-books. The Library is a member of FLO and NELINET.
