Hebrew College, a fully accredited, institution of advanced Judaic studies and adult learning, offers undergraduate, Masters and Doctoral degree programs with concentrations in Jewish Studies, Jewish Education, Music, and other Judaic disciplines. The library of Hebrew College (<http://www.hebrewcollege.edu/library>) supports these programs with a comprehensive collection in all areas of Judaic and Hebraic study. In addition, it serves as a community library, open to the public. The collection of 120,000 volumes is evenly divided into Hebrew and English, with a fair amount of Yiddish and German. Within its collections, particular subject areas of interest are Jewish Education, including an in-depth collection of curriculum material for all levels of students; Jewish Medical Ethics; Responsa Literature; Hasidism; Kabbalah; the Middle East and Israel; a microfilm collection of important Judaica resources; Rare books and manuscripts; and, an extensive collection of cds, video and audio-cassettes, including reference CD-Rom disks for searching the Encyclopaedia Judaica, the Soncino Talmud in English, the Bible, both the Babylonian and Jerusalem Talmud, Midrash, Zohar, and Codes in Hebrew.

The Library is a member of the Fenway Library Consortium (FLC), and Boston's Metrowest Massachusetts Regional Library System.
