Massachusetts College of Art, founded in 1873, is the nation's oldest publicly funded college of the art and design and offers the BFA in four majors (Art History, Art Education, Design & Fine Arts) with twenty-one concentrations. The school also offers the MFA and Master of Science in Art Education. The Morton R. Godine Library contains materials that support teaching and research in all areas of the college's curriculum. The collection includes approximately 90,000 books; 400 periodical subscriptions; 120,000 slides; 3,000 videos; 800 films; rare books; artists' books; and archival collections.
