WHAT?

Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences is a private coeducational college offering professional and pre-professional degrees in pharmacy & health sciences. MCPHS is the largest college of pharmacy in the United States. MCPHS was founded in 1823- the second oldest college of pharmacy in the United States and the oldest institution of higher education in the City of Boston. The College also has branch campuses in Worcester, Massachusetts and Manchester, New Hampshire.

The Sheppard Library is a pharmaceutical and medical information center that maintains a collection of over 40,000 volumes and an archives collection documenting the history of the College. Approximately 700 serials subscriptions are received annually. More than 125 electronic books and over 650 electronic journals may be accessed electronically via the Shepard Library web site. Individual and consortia arrangements with several database vendors and publishers, provides access to over 2,000 additional full-text electronic journals. While the major strengths of the collection are pharmacy education, drug information, medicinal herbs, medicinal chemistry and clinical medicine, strong holdings are also maintained in the core subjects representing the college's programs in several allied health disciplines.
